



Who Am I? A Toy Menagerie

Instructions for Grown-Ups:

Focus: Language Development (Vocabulary & Understanding)

This activity uses the characters from the story to help your child learn new words and follow simple instructions.

What You'll Need:

The storybook, "Amy and Opus's Wobbly Dance".

A few of your child's stuffed animals (ideally similar to the characters, like a bunny, a dinosaur, etc.).

Instructions:

Sit with your child and open the book to a page showing all the toys. Point to each character and say its name clearly. For example: "This is Vuu the elephant. Can you say elephant?"

Make the sound for each animal and see if your child will copy you. "The T-rex gives a big ROAR!" "The penguin has a little SQUEAK!"

Gather your child's own toys. Ask them simple questions to see if they understand.

"Can you give the bunny a pat?"

"Please give the elephant to me."

"Where is your teddy bear?"

Praise your child for pointing, naming, and following along!

What Your Child is Learning:

This game helps build your child's vocabulary by associating words with pictures and objects. Following your requests also strengthens their listening and comprehension skills.
